1. CBRC encourages secondary school students over the age of 15 and tertiary students to take up the sport of rowing within the Club.
2. CBRC encourages all students either individually or as a crew to become members of the Club.
3. Educational institutions are encouraged to organise crews to become members of the Club.
4. Individuals that join the Club through the above avenues are required to comply with the Club and Rowing Victoria by-laws.
5. Members are encouraged to participate in inter school and inter varsity /collegiate events in their respective school or university colours. Club equipment and infrastructure would generally be available for use in these regattas.
6. If members wish to enter regattas that are open to both Club and schools / universities / colleges, members should race in the CBRC colours.
7. Members are discouraged from only entering inter school events and would be expected to also compete in open events in Club colours.
8. Where there is insufficient equipment to cater for the needs of these two types of regattas or training programs, the Club events and training programs would be accorded a higher priority.
9. The CBRC Committee has the discretion to alter these rules from time to time.
