- 1. CBRC encourages secondary school students over the age of 15 and tertiary students to take up the sport of rowing within the Club.
- 2. CBRC encourages all students either individually or as a crew to become members of the Club.
- 3. Educational institutions are encouraged to organise crews to become members of the Club.
- 4. Individuals that join the Club through the above avenues are required to comply with the Club and Rowing Victoria by-laws.
- 5. Members are encouraged to participate in inter school and inter varsity /collegiate events in their respective school or university colours. Club equipment and infrastructure would generally be available for use in these regattas.
- 6. If members wish to enter regattas that are open to both Club and schools / universities / colleges, members should race in the CBRC colours.
- 7. Members are discouraged from only entering inter school events and would be expected to also compete in open events in Club colours.
- 8. Where there is insufficient equipment to cater for the needs of these two types of regattas or training programs, the Club events and training programs would be accorded a higher priority.
- 9. The CBRC Committee has the discretion to alter these rules from time to time.
